

FIRE SERVICE MEMORIAL

In memory of deceased, State of Oregon fire service members, the OFDDA and OFCA conduct a memorial service at the commencement of their joint conference every year.

Any deceased Oregon Fire personnel may be memorialized.

The application must include the deceased's name, rank, years of service, and department.

The name of the person being remembered will be inscribed on a brass plate and will be added to the memorial plaque in the Fire Service Center.

Applications must come from a fire service organization in Oregon and must include the details of why the person is to be memorialized.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All funds contributed to the Memorial Fund will be used for two purposes:

To provide and maintain plaques and other materials necessary to carry out the memorial.

For the purchase, development or improvement of the Fire Service Center.

Funds are expected to be derived from two sources:

Donations accompanying a memorial application and;

Individuals, companies or organizations wishing to support the memorial.

Contributors: Contributors of \$1,000.00 or more will be listed on the Key Contributors Plaque. Names of other contributors will be appropriately displayed in the building.
