### LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE

#### 1.0 **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Policy is to maintain a standing committee with the responsibility of reviewing all proposed legislation affecting the fire services.

#### 2.0 **SCOPE**

This Policy applies to all persons directly or indirectly associated with the Oregon Fire District Directors Association.

#### 3.0 **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

3.1 The committee shall advise the Board of Directors of the status of all proposed legislation affecting fire services and make recommendations concerning such matters to the Board. In addition, the committee shall, through the Legislative Consultant, initiate such legislation as the Board of Directors directs.

3.2 Only committee members shall be entitled to vote.

#### 3.3 Duties of the Chairperson

3.3.1 The Chair or Designee shall attend meetings of the Oregon Fire Services Legislative Committee, and call meetings at other times as deemed necessary.

3.3.2 Communicates directly with the consultant to keep informed on the progress of pertinent legislation.

3.3.3 Disseminate information to committee members relative to proposed or pending legislation.

3.3.4 Accept proposals from the fire services concerning subjects needing legislative action.

3.3.5 Bring proposals to the attention of appropriate legislative committee divisions (Fire Marshal, Director, Fire Chief, etc.).

- 3.3.6 To recommend a member of OFDDA to SDAO for inclusion on their legislative committee.
