SAFETY CREDIT ELIGIBILITY

1.0 PURPOSE

Safety credits may be awarded each year to districts who have met all of the eligibility requirements set forth in this policy.

2.0 SCOPE

This Policy applies to all fire districts in the state of Oregon.

3.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

3.1 Eligibility Criteria-Eligible recipients must meet all of the following criteria:

3.1.1 Eligible recipients must be current in their membership dues for the Oregon Fire District Directors Association (OFDDA) as of December 15 of the award year .

3.1.2 Eligible recipients must be current in their membership dues for the Special Districts Association of Oregon as of December 15 of the award year.

3.1.3 Eligible recipients must have been represented at least twice at OFDDA-sponsored training events during the award year. The annual Joint OFDDA/OFCA Conference shall count as a training event.

3.1.4 Award year is defined as the year in which the safety credit award is granted.

3.1.5 Representation at OFDDA-sponsored training events must be either a district board member or a chief officer affiliated with the district. ". . represented at least twice.." will be fulfilled by a minimum of two representatives attending one event or one representative attending two events.

3.2 Safety Credit Amount

3.2.1 The amount of the safety credit will be determined annually by the Executive Board of the Oregon Fire District Directors Association.

Note: On September 26, 2009, the OFDDA Board of Directors, by consensus, agreed to VOID this policy. During discussions which included OFDDA's legal counsel, it was determined that the policy was not needed since the OFDDA Safety Credit program was phased out. Further, the policy was renumbered to address duplicate number assigned to an active policy.
